#### ALL APPLICANTS MUST SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

#### • A cover letter that includes:

- ► Your name
- Home address
- ▶ Telephone number
- Email address
- List of attached documentation
- A 1,000-word essay describing your interest in pursuing your intended area of study, technical or vocational program. Essay submissions should be typed and double-spaced.
- **Proof of residency** (examples include a copy of a utility bill addressed to a parent or guardian, or your driver's license).
- An original copy of your High School Transcript.
- A copy of a letter of acceptance from a college, university, technical or vocational program for the 2023–2024 academic year.
- Two letters of recommendation.
